Alpines, Bulbs & Perennials

[*Arum italicum* 'Marmoratum'](#) (Araceae) £ 2.50

Syn. *A. i.* 'Pictum' Hardy European aroid cultivated for hundreds of years because of the broad cream veined arrow-shaped leaves. 40cm (6)   BCH


[*Colchicum agrippinum*](#) (Colchicaceae) £ 3.25

'Autumn Crocus' Lovely short tessellated (chequered, like a snake's-head fritillary) 'naked lady' flower of pale & darker pinky magenta produced in autumn after the leaves die down. 12cm (5)

[*Cyrtanthus brachyscyphus*](#) (Amaryllidaceae) £ 2.75



Tough easy small South African bulb related to *Amaryllis*. Good dark narrow foliage & orange tubular flowers in clusters at the top of spikes mostly in mid-late summer, though flowers can be produced year round. Grow as a pot plant as it won't survive the winter unprotected outside.

[*Dianella caerulea* 'Little Jess'](#) (Hemerocallidaceae) £ 4.00

Sword leaved foliage plant related to *Phormium*. Neat dense evergreen olive green foliage fans & an unusual habit with short stems holding up the fans of leaves. Deep blue flowers followed by dark blue berries. 50cm (9)  A# 

[*Dianella revoluta* 'Little Rev'](#) (Hemerocallidaceae) £ 4.00

Narrower sea green foliage densely packed & upright, a good neat drought tolerant evergreen container plant. Blue flowers & berries in summer. 50cm (9)  A# 

[Dierama Plantworld Hybrids](#) (Iridaceae) £ 4.00


Pulcherrimum hybrids with grassy foliage & slightly nodding clusters of flowers in various shades from white through pink to deep magenta-purple, though most often variations a fairly deep plummy pink. 60-100cm (8)  AB 

[*Erigeron glaucus* 'Sea Breeze'](#) (Asteraceae) £ 2.00

'Coastal Daisy' A new selection of a very hardy low growing perennial. Large mauve-pink & yellow daisies are produced all summer above a dense carpet of slightly glaucous foliage. 15cm

[*Erythronium albidum*](#) (Liliaceae) £ 3.25

Rarely seen, quite tricky Eastern American species with white back-sweeping flowers in spring & mottled leaves. 12cm (4)  BH

[Gunnera magellanica](#) (Gunneraceae)

£ 2.50

Dwarf foliage plant from Chile, Tierra del Fuego & the Falkland Islands. Mat forming evergreen with dark green kidney shaped leaves. Easily grown in damp soils, an interesting companion to the full size species. 10cm (7) ☀️🌑🌒 CH 🌿🌿🌿

[Osteospermum ecklonis](#) (Asteraceae)

£ 2.00

Chalk white daisies with ray florettes with rounded tips on fairly upright hardy plants that start blooming in late spring & will keep on going all summer & into autumn. 40cm (9) ☀️ A 🌿🌿

[Osteospermum 'Weetwood'](#) (Asteraceae)

£ 2.00

White daisies produced all summer on a tough low growing perennial. 25cm (8) ☀️ A 🌿🌿

[Polemonium pauciflorum](#) (Polemoniaceae)

£ 2.25

An unfairly named perennial Jacob's Ladder, pauciflorum means "few flowered", it produces plenty of long narrow tubed flowers, soft apricot flaring to red at the tips on the outside, pale yellow inside produced for most of the summer. 30cm (7) A

[Primula pulverulenta](#) (Primulaceae) [Prolifera]

£ 2.25

Tall spike of rich cerise-purple flowers with red eyes on lightly farina dusted stems, earlier than most Candelabras, it is the easiest to grow & the most likely to self-seed. 75cm (6) ☀️🌑 CH

[Sonchus fruticosus](#) (Asteraceae)

£ 2.50

'Lingua de vaca' [Port.: 'Cow's Tongue'] A giant Madeiran tree-like sow thistle! Shrub with glossy evergreen dandelion leaves & big open heads of bright yellow dandelion-like daisy flowers in summer. Very impressive & exotic looking. 3m (9) ☀️ AB

[Trillium catesbyi](#) (Melanthiaceae)

£ 4.25

'Bashful Wake-robin' Pedicilate species notable for it's large but elusive ivory flower hidden below the leaves. Plant near a path where it can be revealed to visitors without collateral damage. 30cm (7) 🌑 BH

[Trillium cuneatum](#) (Melanthiaceae)

£ 3.25

'Large Toadshade' Strongly marbled leaves, dark crimson maroon sessile (stalk-less) flower in late spring. One of the easiest sessile species. 30cm (5) 🌑 BH

Shrubs

[Brachyglottis bidwillii](#) (Asteraceae)

£ 2.50

Syn. *Senecio b.* Dwarf evergreen shrub, thick leathery leaves similar to the better known *B. buchananii* hort., though more elliptic than rounded. 30cm (8) ☀️ BH# 🌿

[Camellia 'Freedom Bell'](#) (Theaceae)

£ 6.50

Long flowering floriferous Camellia producing many semi double red quite narrow petaled flowers from late winter to spring. With glossy dark green foliage. 3m (8) 🌑 BH# 🌿

[Cistus x laxus 'Snow White'](#) (Cistaceae)

£ 2.25

White un-blotched flowers all summer on a substantial mounding bush with quite narrow green slightly wavy foliage. Unlike most *Cistus* it responds to pruning, so perhaps a potential hedger? 1m (8) ☀️ A 🌿

[Cistus x pulverulentus 'Sunset'](#) (Cistaceae)

£ 2.25

A compact shrub with wavy-margined greyish leaves & dark rose-pink, yellow centred flowers all summer. 60cm (8) ☀️ A 🌿

[**Fuchsia 'Lady Boothby'** \(Onagraceae\)](#)

£ 2.25

Reasonably frost hardy Fuchsia with stout deep red & purple flowers with large dark foliage. It is notable for its scandent habit, allowing it to be grown against a wall as a climber. To 2m (9)

[**Hydrangea serrata 'Bluebird'** \(Hydrangeaceae\)](#)

£ 2.25

Quite small leaved form often flushing red & with autumn colour. Masses of small magenta-blue (pink in limey soil) lacecap flowers. 1.2m (6) ☀️● B# 🌿

[**Hydrangea White Lacecap** \(Hydrangeaceae\)](#)

£ 2.25

Vigorous & very fine Lacecap that has grown for many years in the garden of the big house next door to the nursery. The flowers last well & the bracts retain their brilliant white colouring, prominent beside the bright green foliage. 1.75m (7) ● BH 🌿

[**Luma apiculata 'Saint Hillary'** \(Myrtaceae\)](#)

£ 4.50

Syn. *Myrtus luma* 'St H.' A variegated evergreen tree with fragrant white flowers, older plants have cinnamon bark which peels to reveal white patches. Similar to 'Glanleam Gold' but brighter & with a pink flush to the younger leaves. 5m (9) ☀️● AB#

[**Olearia algida** \(Asteraceae\)](#)

£ 2.50

Dwarf aromatic evergreen Australian shrub with a dense habit of greyish-white shoots with tiny scale-like dark green leaves. An attractive tough little bush that should be more widely grown. 60cm (8) ☀️ A# 🌿

[**Olearia paniculata** \(Asteraceae\)](#)

£ 4.00

'Akiraho' Popular in New Zealand for taller hedges in coastal districts, it has attractive mid green wavy leaves with a pale buff underside & a leathery texture. Attractive as a tree with smooth cinnamon bark which peels in long strips. 6m (9) ☀️● AB 🌿

[**Podocarpus acutifolius** \(Podocarpaceae\)](#)

£ 2.50

'Needle-leaved Totora' Dwarfish bushy conifer from New Zealand with tightly packed quite sharp tipped limy green needles, it grows into a dense thicket about twice as wide as tall. 1.4m (7) ☀️ B# 🌿
